MAMIE LEE FRIERSON



Mamie L. Frierson was born on November 11, 1919 in South Carolina. She was a 1943 graduate of Saint Agnes Hospital School of Nursing in North Carolina. From the "Station Hospital History Changes in Duty Assignments from 1 November 1944 to 28 February 1945" mentioned 2LT Mamie Frierson as a General Duty Nurse.

LT Frierson is reported as being on staff in the March 15, 1946 station hospital roster and was one of the five remaining nurses on Tuskegee Army Air Field (TAAF) as it closed. She died on July 25, 2009 and is buried at Ashdale Cemetery in Tuskegee, Alabama.

LT Frierson was married to a Nelson Boggan, Sr. Her son, Nelson Boggan, Jr. died with his father in a car accident in 1971 and they are also buried at the Ashdale Cemetery. Frierson's twin sister, Pearlle, died a few months after her sister.
