## RUTH L. CARTER



Second Lieutenant Ruth L. Carter was a Surgical Nurse at Tuskegee Army Air Field (TAAF), located in Tuskegee, Alabama. She was born February 10, 1907 in Prospect Virginia.

Ruth Carter received her nursing training from Freedman's Hospital Training School of Nursing in Washington, D.C. She was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in 1943. It was noted in the July 15, 1946, station hospital roster that 2LT Carter had been promoted to First Lieutenant, but was now separated from the service. A family member reports that she continued her education

at Virginia State College, Howard and Catholic Universities.

1LT Carter joined the Lonely Eagles Chapter on September 10, 1979 in East Orange, New Jersey. Her remains are located in her hometown of Prospect Virginia.
