Second Lieutenant Mencie B. Trotter also served on the base at Tuskegee Army Air Field (TAAF). She was one of the four Tuskegee Army Nurses who graduated from St. Philip School of Nursing in Richmond, Virginia. She was in the class of 1940. As a matter of fact, after her military career, she joined the faculty of St. Philip. She was in the service from October 1942 to April 1945. She, too, was in the *Wings Over America 1942 Yearbook* of the Tuskegee Army Air Forces, 66th Flight Training Detachment and Army Air Force, SE Training Center. Trotter was born June 17, 1919 in Roxboro, North Carolina, although her home town is listed as Richmond, Virginia. She was a Medical Nurse at the station hospital. She joined the Lonely Eagles Chapter on August 29, 2000 and was buried at Carolina Biblical Gardens in Wake County, North Carolina. She earned America Campaign and WWII medals as did others in the military service during World War II.
