Sarah F. Thomas also served at the Station Hospital at Tuskegee Army Air Field during World War II. She is listed as a Second Lieutenant in the 1942 *Wings Over America* yearbook of the Tuskegee Army Flying School Army Air Forces, 66th Flight Training Detachment and Army Air Forces, SE Training Center. She was from Marion, Alabama and is believed to have been born around 1920. She is also believed to have been a nursing student at Hampton Institute in Hampton, Virginia. According to the base newspaper, LT Thomas was among the first of three Tuskegee Army "Negro Nurses to carry services to foreign soil to Liberia" on April 4, 1943. She retired from the military on November 30, 1946.
